

Sherrill Gambill, Duke Power Retiree, Dies



Sherrill Thomas Gambill, 77, of North Wilkesboro, died Wednesday, April 16, 2014 at Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center.

The funeral service will be held 11 a.m., Saturday, April 19, 2014 at the Hinshaw Street Baptist Church with the Rev. Sherrill Wellborn officiating. Burial will be in Mountlawn Memorial Park.

The family will receive friends Friday from 6 until 8 p.m., at Reins-Sturdivant Funeral Home.
